Second Creek Raceway is Still Alive

In 2004, Commerce City, which includes the Reunion and Frontera subdivisions, did not receive any complaints about noise, lights, or traffic from Second Creek Raceway. A different scenario from the dirt track next to 2nd Creek. Since the people in the homes located nearby haven't had any complaints all of the track's operating conditions have stayed the same as what they were in 2004. Cars can be run from 8:00 AM to 8:00 PM or dusk

whichever comes first. Test and tune will be run from Mon. through Fri. Racing, driver's schools, and high speed driving (ZCCC) will be held on Sat. and Sun.

If there is a complaint about noise from the track Commerce City Police Dept. will be called to measure the noise level at the edge of the property owned by the person complaining about the noise. The maximum sound level allowed there will be 50 dB. If the sound level maximum is violated the use permit for the track could be cancelled. Since most street cars sound level is 70-75 dB at the tailpipe and all of the cars using 2nd Creek are required to have mufflers there shouldn't be any problem with noise being above 50 dB at the existing homes.

I have signed up ZCCC for our traditional Saturday dates in June and September. At least we'll have one more year of safe local high speed driving and at the same time make money for ZCCC. Also, ZCCC members, by showing a current membership card, should be able to run at 2nd Creek between Christmas and New Years without having to pay any fee.

As a side note Rocky Mountain National Speedway, the dirt track next to 2nd Creek, also got their Conditional Use Permit extended. However, their operating conditions changed based on inputs from nearby residents. Their hours of operation are from 5:00 PM to 11:00 PM. No more racing at 12:00 Midnight or 1:00 in the morning. The noise limits are the same as for Second Creek Raceway. If they violate the 50dB leve, their permit will be pulled and the track shutdown. They too will not be able to get any kind of an extension after Nov. 1, 2005.


