January 19, 2009



I hope everyone had a safe and fun Christmas and Chanukah, and a Happy New Year, but now that it is 2009, it's time to assess where we are as a club. The reason I say this, for those of you who don't know, our former sponsor, Tynan's Nissan, is just that -- our former sponsor. Due to the present economic atmosphere, they are no longer able to contribute to our Club. I'm told that big bucks had to be cut from their budget, and we are a casualty of their economic shortfalls. They aren't the only ones in this position. Officers of the club have approached 2 other Nissan dealers to see if they were interested in stepping up to sponsor us. They are not. It's too bad. I personally think that sponsorship of ZCCC was, and would continue to be, of great value to any Nissan dealer. I personally shifted my service work on our 3 Nissans to Tynan's when they became our sponsor. Had I bought a new Nissan while they were our sponsor, I certainly would have bought it from them. I know of a member who just bought a new Xterra from Tynan's.

I believe that I alone may have spent more in their service department than the sponsorship cost them. This of course includes having my 1990 300ZXTT suspension rebuilt from the ground up to the chassis last year. There was a lot of labor involved in replacing every bushing I could, as well as a new brake system. I purchased new shocks and spring's through Tynan's and of course the labor to install those was also involved.

All our oil changes and scheduled maintenance was also done at Tynan's. I say this not as sour grapes for having lost their monetary support, but as an example of the value the club returned to Tynan's. We all know that Tynan's was very generous to us. They provided not only the monthly stipend, but put on the BBQ's at the Shine and Show's, donated door prizes for drawings, let us use their conference facility and gave us a 20% discount on parts and labor. I personally appreciate everything that Tynan's did for us. I point out my expenditures only as some measure of value that they received in return. The Club truly appreciates what they have done for us over the years, and we thank them for their support. I hope that we are both able to ride out these tough economic times and that we can renew what I believe is a mutually beneficial relationship in the future.

As we move into 2009, we have taken on the regional Mid-west Z Fest for September 2009. All the members involved in this huge undertaking are determined to make this at least a break even proposition though there is a good probability that our club can make a little money from this, though that is not the reason to hold the event. We are doing this because we believe that we can put on a quality event that Z Car enthusiasts can

really enjoy in the sometimes breathtaking, but always enjoyable, setting of the Rocky Mountains. Check it out, and while I am on the subject of our website, some members have suggested that our website is outdated and needs to be snazzier and updated. 


#### Mid-west Z Fest 2009

Then I heard him exclaim as we blasted from sight, "Merry Christmas to all, and what a great night!"



**Craig Williams** won the  $50\50$  in the sum of \$40.50.




