Meet at the Estes Park Fairgrounds ticket purchasing area at 11am, located at 1209 Manford Ave, Estes Park, CO 80517



When was the last time you went to the museum? The Denver Art Museum is hosting an in-depth exploration of Vincent Van Gogh. "Becoming Van Gogh" examines the artists evolution through his art work and other artists. The collection of artwork is on loan from more then 60 public and private collections throughout Europe and North America.

We will meet at Little Shanghai Café (directions below) for lunch at 11:30 and be at the Museum for the 1:30 admission. Everyone can view the exhibit at their own speed and explore other parts of the museum afterward. The Museum closes at 5 pm

Parking at the Cultural Complex Garage start at \$1.00 per hour. Access the garage off of 12th avenue and Broadway


Driving Directions:





December Trivia Answers

Thank You Roy Davis for helping to provide the answers

What is the Kwaishinsha Company? Nissan Motor Company, An automobile factory, first car produced 1914 called a DAT, 2-cylinder.

What year did Sotaro Hashimoto start the Kwaishinsha Company? Established 1911

Where did the name Datsun come from and when? Answer 1: DAT after the initials of his backers, in Japanese Dat means "fast hare". 1930 they produced a baby car and named it Datson or "son of Dat". Answer 2: In 1918, Kwaishinsha made a fresh start, manufacturing military vehicles. At the same time, though, it continued development of a small passenger car. After changing its name to Dat Jidosha Seizo Co., it completed work on the DATSON in 1931. Tobata Casting Co., Ltd., who was manufacturing the automobile parts, merged with DAT Jidosha Seizo Co., affiliated 1932. The birth of Datsun (changed from Datson).

What existing Datsun motor was the engine in the 240Z developed from? The 4 cylinder OHC in the Datsun 1600. The engine was a copy of the 1960's six-cylinder Mercedes-Benz 220 engine, by adding two extra cylinders in the 240Z the cylinder count was back to six.

What was the first model with a V6 motor? 1984 Z31

When was the first 240Z/Fairlady Z sold and where? The original Z was sold in October 1969 in Japan as the Nissan Fairlady Z and was sold in Japan at Nissan Exhibition dealerships that previously sold the Nissan Bluebird. Z Car HLS30 00016 is the first Datsun 240Z sold to the public here in the U.S.A. It is still owned by a private owner in the Tampa Bay area of Florida.

List the letter and number designation for each Z generation? Hint: there are 6 generations. \$30, \$130, \$231, \$232, \$233, \$234

What year was the first turbocharged model Z introduced? 1981

What was the horse power rating for a Z31? VG30E naturally aspirated producing 160 and VG30ET turbocharged forms 200 bhp respectively, although some VG30ET powered Z-cars exported outside of the US produced 228 bhp due to longer cam duration and less emission restrictions.

What was the horse power rating for the Z32 Turbo and non Turbo? Naturally aspirated 3.0-liter V6 engine produced a rated 222 hp and 198 lb·ft. The turbo variant, now upgraded with twin Garrett turbochargers and dual intercoolers was good for 300 hp along with 283 lb·ft of torque.

How much did a restored Nissan 240Z at select dealerships cost in 1998? The original 240Z's were professionally restored and re-sold for \$24,950

What single color did Nissan use for their concept car in 2001? On January 8, 2001 the Z concept debuted at the North American International Auto Show and was painted a bright orange.

Who is the most notable driver to be associated with Nissan Z and on Bob Sharp's racing team?
