





SPONSORSHIP 2009



I'm sure most of you have heard by now that our sponsor, Tynan's Nissan is unable to continue their financial contribution per our past sponsorship agreement. This did come as a bit of a surprise, but not a shock.

So where do we go from here? During this time of economic turmoil, it would be very unlikely that anyone would pick up the sponsorship package that we have enjoyed with Tynan's. approached other dealerships after getting the news from Tynan's, but no one wants to sponsor us at this time. During the last seven years, we were actually wooed by other dealerships to change sponsors -but we stood resolute by Tynan's. The whole sponsorship package was a win-win situation for ZCCC and Tynan's. We enjoyed a much-needed financial boost to cover the ever-growing expense of the Odometer, as well as gifts, door prizes and an ongoing camaraderie such as our annual go cart races and dealer appreciation BBQ. Most important are the relationships that have developed over the years, like that between our club and the dealership. Many of us have developed personal friendships with people at Tynan's. I also feel that our club has flourished due, in part, to our partnership with Tynan's.

At our last general meeting, Daryl Shuck, General Manager for Tynan's, spoke of the automotive hard times that may continue to loom over the automotive industry for the next year or longer. Everyday on the nightly news we hear about this or that company going under. Car sales are at an all





time low, and my personal favorite: corporate bailouts. It's not very pretty out there for any automotive dealership. In a conversation with Daryl before Christmas, I was informed two more dealerships on Havana had to close their doors.

Daryl also spoke of the excellent relationship that Tynan's has enjoyed with ZCCC. It was stated that Tynan's wishes to continue this relationship with ZCCC. Tynan's proposed the following: the sponsorship package will stay in place as is, except for the \$200.00 monthly contribution. To try and make up for the lost \$200/month, Tynan's has offered an opportunity to make more each month by referring customers to Tynan's and receiving a referral fee of \$200 for any automobile sold to the customers we send them.

As the sponsor liaison for ZCCC, my charge was to acquire and maintain a sponsor for ZCCC. Is this as good as our last contract? Probably not. Do we cut and run? Where to? At this time there are very few, if any, options available to us. I personally think that staying the course with Tynan's for the upcoming year, with a gentleman's agreement, is our best option. As sponsor liaison, for me, this is an easy call.

Daryl and I have worked out the details and agreed to revisit this in December 2009. To be honest, I have developed personal friendships with members of Tynan's team. In all fairness, and not to project my bias on the issue, I feel this matter should be put to a discussion and referendum vote by the membership at our next meeting.
