Day Drive to Fort Laramie, National Historical Site By John Bilodeau

Come drive with us to visit historic Fort Laramie **April 30, 2005**, in South Eastern Wyoming (depending on the weather). The Fort is an authentic U.S. Calvary Outpost founded in 1849 as part of the military presence along the Oregon Trail. We will be meeting at **9 am at the Wagon Road Park-N-Ride at 120th and I-25** (west side of I-25). From there, we will proceed up I-25 to Cheyenne, Wyoming. Just north of Cheyenne, we will exit I-25, catch Wyoming Highway 85, and proceed east to Torrington. We will continue on 85 until 85 becomes Wyoming Highway 26 at Lingle about 10 miles north of Torrington. From Lingle, we will continue North on Highway 26 about 11 miles to the town of Fort Laramie where we will exit Highway 26 at State Route 160 and cross the North Platte River for a quick 3 mile drive to the National Historical Site.

We will have lunch in Torrington. We will return home the same way until Cheyenne where you can either catch I-25 or go south on Highway 85.

We have a tentative agreement with the Spring Valley Golf Club in Elizabeth CO for a tournament that will start about 10am on Monday June 13. The cost will be about \$65 per person which will include all the expenses for golf including golf, range balls and a cart plus some

additional benefits in the pro shop.

Spring Valley Golf club is situated along Running Creek in western Elbert County and is located about 15 minutes southeast of the town of Parker. The fairways are lined with many mature cottonwood trees and our back 9 has the reputation of being one of the most scenic in the Denver Metro area. The golf course plays anywhere from 5200 yards to 7150 yards, depending on the tees you play. We have a complete practice facility available with driving range, chipping area and putting green to facilitate any practice prior to play.

Our clubhouse is 10,000 sq. ft., and contains our restaurant, grill and lounge area, and fully stocked pro shop. Our patio is connected on the second floor to our restaurant and gives a beautiful view over the course and Running Creek. The restaurant is truly a great setting for after play dining and awards.

Our food and beverage team can customize a meal package to meet your needs for your individual outing. We offer a wide variety of choices, from box lunch (\$8.95pp) to prime rib buffet (\$24.95pp). Our food and beverage manager, John Croce 303.646.4240, ext. 12 can help you plan the details.
