
Zunday Drive to Monument for Lunch



We will be staying 2 nights, Friday and Saturday at the KbarS Lodge in Keystone, South Dakota. You can make your reservations by calling (605) 666-4545 or 1-866-522-7724 or on line at reservations@kbarslodge.com. This is an email link to the lodge. We will meet Friday May 20th at 7:00 a.m. to go over the route and hand out the maps and park entrance info. If you have walkie talkies please bring them. We will leave promptly at 7:30 a.m. The meeting place is the Sears Grande parking lot off of I25 and highway 7 located approx 12 miles north of Denver.

I have planned a route with some stops of interest such as Pawnee Grasslands in Colorado. Agate Fossil Bed National Monument in Nebraska, and the Mammoth Site in South Dakota.

I hope to arrive at Keystone at 4:30 p.m. We will get our rooms and have dinner somewhere in Keystone or Custer. We have a time crunch if we want to make it to the lighting of Crazy Horse on Friday night. The gates to the park close at 6:30 p.m. and the lighting is at 8:30 p.m. We may have to be on our own for this meal. I am checking with the Crazy Horse Park to see if there are any places to eat once we get into the park.

Saturday May 21s. After breakfast at the lodge, we will go to Mt. Rushmore. We will stay there till about noon, and then have a drive on the Needles highway loop in the afternoon. If you do not want to go on the drive you can do what ever you want in the area. Dinner will be at 5.30 or so that evening. (Location to be determined).

Sunday May 22nd. We will have breakfast at the lodge. Then everyone is free to go home any route back you choose, or stay longer in the area.

A complete itinerary will be provided at the start of our trip including maps with stop locations on the way up there. Park entrance fees and info.

Be sure to get your reservations at the lodge by April 20th. Make sure you mention the ZCCC to get the group rate of \$89.99 per room per night. Free breakfast included.

I am planning a weekend trip to La Veta, Colorado in order to drive the Highway of Legends, Colorado Hwy 12, between La Veta and Trinidad going around the west and south side of Spanish Peaks. It is a winding, scenic road in the mountains of Southern Colorado. La Veta is a small artsy town west of Walsenburg. We will drive down on Saturday morning and check in, at the La Veta Inn. It is a renovated hotel in the middle of La Veta and they are revamping the plumbing as I write this. The hotel has offered a 10% discount on the rooms and will hold a block of 10 rooms for us until May 25. This is their busy season and any concession is pretty good. 
