

President's Corner


The activities for ZCCC are accelerating....much like most of us in our Z car! The month of April had two weekend events, in addition to our regular General Meeting.

In our dealings with CSP they reserve the right to pull a confirmed track date if necessary. This time there was a previous booking for our date unknown to us (and forgotten by them) at the time we confirmed the ZCCC date. The earlier confirmed date is for a Special Olympics type event. It had also been confirmed a couple of months ahead of our date. Due to the change in command at the driving center, the date was never properly recorded and we were about to be bumped with no other track dates available.

The track committee had already gone to a lot of work to set the upcoming event up with a special added attraction and we were about to lose our June 16th track date. Never fear! We have managed to salvage a significant portion of the day. Our option was this or nothing.

The Z Car Club would like to thank Ian Lawless, head of the Special Olympics event. Without his help, our track event would not have happened. Through a flurry of phone calls and E-mails we were able to set up the track event in the below listed manner. We apologize for any problems this will cause but this was the best schedule we could set up under the circumstances.

I would also like to thank Pam & Gary for allowing a rewrite and the necessary time to correct this problem. We received our notice from CSP on the April 23rd -- the

article cut off date. If your ODOMETER was late, blame me.

Please understand that all concerned with the track event will have to work together to make this event work. It is an amended schedule, but we will be able to have the track from about 1:00 PM till dark.

The most important thing: participants can help us – be sure to have your car Tech'd before the June 16th event.


Due to the schedule change, ZCCC will be hosting a BBQ with burgers and brats for those who wish to stay for the performance driving class.

PINEAPPLE MILLIONAIRE PIE

(Chili cook-off winning dessert recipe)
Charlotte Robertson

2 cups powdered sugar

2 baked 8 inch pie crusts or 1 baked 10 inch pie

1 stick butter or margarine, softened

1 large egg

1 cup heavy whipping cream

1/4 tsp salt

1 cup drained, crushed pineapple

1/4 tsp vanilla

½ cup chopped pecans

Cream together softened butter and 1 & 3/4 cups powdered sugar. Add egg, salt and vanilla.

Mix until light and fluffy. Spoon mixture into 8 inch pie crusts or one 10 inch pie crust.

Whip cream until stiff. Blend in remaining 1/4 cup powdered sugar, pineapple and nuts. Spoon on top of egg mixture and chill thoroughly.

Can you believe it? Thanks to the incredible cooperation and support from all of the Denver area car clubs including Z Car Club of Colorado, Cerebral Palsy of Colorado this year will celebrate the 24th Annual Exotic Sports Car Show and Concours d' Elegance. Over \$592,000 for Cerebral Palsy of Colorado's children's programs has been raised.

The show is made possible through the joint efforts of \mathbf{Z} Car Club of Colorado, The Porsche Club of America/Rocky Mountain Region, Rocky Mountain Jaguar Club, Ferrari Club of America-Rocky Mountain Region, Mercedes-Benz Club of America Mile-High Section, **Looking Glass** Association, Rocky Mountain 356 Porsche Club, NSX Club of America-Southwest Region, Z Car Club of Colorado, Rocky Mountain Chapter-BMW Car Club of America, Mile High Chapter of S2KCA, Classic Car Club of America-Colorado Region, Rocky Mountain Saab Club of Colorado, Audi Car Club North America Rocky Mountain Chapter and Mile **High Rotary Club.**

This year's event is scheduled for Sunday, June 10, 2007 on the front lawn of Arapahoe Community College, located at 5900 South Santa Fe Drive, in Littleton, Colorado. The show is open to spectators from 9:00 a.m. – 3:00 p.m., and awards will be presented at 2:00 p.m. This gala affair will feature the best and the most beautiful sports, exotic and classic automobiles ranging from early classic and collector cars to vintage and rare current models. If you have participated in the past, you know what an outstanding show this is! Our goal this year is to have 350 cars on display and to raise \$100,000.

There are several ways our club can help to make this event an overwhelming success. 1) Judged All judging will be done above the chassis, no wheel wells or under carriage scoring. Judging will be structured to help first-time exhibitors learn about car preparation for concours events. Cars will be divided and grouped into various classes based on make and year. Please note: Your car must be pre-registered by May 23, 2007 to be judged. If you register late or on the morning of the event, your car will not be judged.

2) Display Display only; no judging will be performed.

Don't delay. Space is limited, so send in your entry form today. The cost to register your car is only \$30 per car if you register before May 23, 2007. After, May 23, 2007, the cost to register a car is \$50.00. You will receive two adult admissions with each registration.

Remember, your car does not need to be a garage queen show car to participate in this event. What could be better than to spend a Sunday displaying your Z with other club members and viewing an incredible assortment of cars? This is the kind of event which makes our passion for our cars so enjoyable.




