
## 600+ HP NISSAN SKYLINE GTR


# Colorado State Patrol Race Track

There will be four different run groups: Novice (including first-timers), Experienced, Advanced and Expert. Driving experience and level of car preparation will determine your run group.

All cars must pass a safety technical inspection, and each driver and passenger must wear approved clothing and a Snell-approved helmet (1985 or newer). If you are unfamiliar with technical inspection or clothing requirements, you may contact Roy Davis (303-979-0711 home or 303-445-3055 at work; RDDAVIS@do.usbr.gov), Chief of the Technical Inspection Crew, with questions regarding the fitness of your Z for the track event.

Tech inspection for this event will be held in late May at a time and location to be announced in the May issue of the Odometer.

Alternatively, you may make a special appointment with Roy Davis to have your car inspected. Contact information for Roy is shown above.


