REDLINE MOTORSPORTS DYNO DAY Dick Spear

Curious about how much horsepower your car is really putting out at the rear wheels? Well, **Saturday June 26, 2004 at 9:00 AM** is when you can find out the real deal. Redline Motorsports, a high-end import and domestic performance shop in Fort Collins, has designated the 26th of June, as ZCCC's day on the dyno (dynamometer). The dyno shows how much horsepower you are getting at the rear wheels, not at the flywheel where the factory rates horsepower.

Now you ask, how much is this going to cost. Well, pricing for three runs on a dyno in the Front Range is anywhere from \$65 to \$100 dollars. Redline has offered ZCCC a great deal. If we have 15 or less vehicles show up you'll be able to get three runs on Redline's dyno for \$45. If we have more than 15 vehicles show up, the price drops to \$40 for 3 runs. These vehicles don't have to be Z cars. If you choose to take three runs between each run you can adjust timing, boost, and anything else you think will make you go faster. At the end of each run you'll get a report graphically showing horsepower, torque and rpm.. In addition, if you so choose, Redline will give you a report on the car's fuel/air ratio readings during each run.

This is a great opportunity, especially for bragging rights to find out how much horsepower your car is really putting out. It's also good for setting a baseline before making any performance improvements to your car. See you at Redline Motorsports, June 26th at 9:00 AM. **Directions are on page 5**.





Double Dose of Track Fun! By Gary Bracken

It's not too late to register for one or both track events coming up right away: 2nd Creek Raceway (near DIA) on June 5th, and the State Patrol Track in Golden on July 10th. Both of these venues provide a fun and safe setting to put your Z through its paces.

To assure that you are comfortable on the track, both events will feature 4 run groups: **Novice** (for first-timers or those who prefer a less-hurried pace; **Intermediate** (for those drivers with some track experience who are comfortable driving a little faster); **Advanced** (those with considerable track experience and skill driving a car that is prepared for rigorous track driving); and **Expert** (drivers with expert skills whose car is capable of safely negotiating the track at near-race speeds).

As you can see, there is a group available that will allow you to enjoy yourself behind the wheel of your Z with the safety and comfort level best suited to your circumstances. So, why try to test the limits of your car on public roads (and risk an accident, or a ticket, or worse) when you can do so on a track safely? Our track events require proper clothing and helmets (Snell certified 1995 or newer), a car that has passed our technical safety

check (tires, steering, brakes, leaks, etc.), and written certification by drivers that they will follow all the safety rules set up by the Z Car Club of Colorado and the Track Steward. Anyone who violates the rules will be sanctioned. Fortunately, in the 12 years that we've been hosting these events, violations of safety rules have been rare — and we've never had a single person injured at our track events.

We also have corner workers at our events to assist the Control Person with information about what they see on their section of the track. For example, if Corner 3 sees that a car is leaking fluid onto the track, they radio the Control Person. Control will then instruct the appropriate corners to give a black flag to that car. The black flag means to exit the track. When the car exits, the Chief Steward (or designee) will talk to the driver and check out the car. The car will not be allowed back on the track until the leak is fixed. Corner workers also perform other functions vital to everyone's safety at the track.

In addition to safe fun on the track, we all have a great time talking with other car owners about their vehicle, driving techniques, and other aspects of driving and sports cars. Won't you join us in June and/or July at one of these outstanding tracks? Please use the registration form in this issue of the *Odometer* to register for either – or both – events.




State Patrol Track Event, July 10th by Mike Goddard


At the end of this summer, we are going to loose Second Creek Racetrack. There are other plans in the works for future track events but for now, we will have to look to current facilities. Last summer we attempted a track event in Golden, Co. at the Colorado State Patrol Track facility. Since this was our first time, we knew we would need to tweak the next event. We have worked out some of the details and I'm sure that this will be a most enjoyable event. The biggest complaint was no food or drinks on site. This problem has been handled and there will be a vendor present with Burritos, Burgers, Brat's and a variety of drinks and other items.

The event **will start at 08:00 am** and will continue through the day until about 5:00 pm. As an added twist to this event, after lunch we will run the opposite direction. We have yet to set a final price but it will be cheaper than Second Creek. I would like to ad a word of caution! Due to the layout of the track, you must cross the track to get to the Paddock area.

If you arrive after 8:00 am, DO NOT enter the track until the gate attendant allows it.
