The 26th Annual Exotic Sports Car Show & Concours d'Elegance is Sunday, **June 14**, 2009, and will be held on the front lawn of Arapahoe Community College.

For two and half decades, we have participated, volunteered and attended this event to help Cerebral Palsy of Colorado provide scholarships for early education, speech and language, and occupational therapies to low income families with disabled children. Last year this event raised \$95,000 for CP of Colorado.

Please plan to participate in this gala event by showing your Z car or attending. There will be over 350 sports, classic, collector cars and this year a special collection of classic motorcycles will be shown. We had 23 Z cars last year on display at this event, which is attended by over 6,000 spectators. Remember, your Z does not need to be a show car nor must it be judged to participate. Plan now to come out and enjoy a wonderful day of camaraderie with other car enthusiasts.

Late registration after May 18th will be \$50. Entrance contribution for spectators is \$10, with children under 12 admitted free. A \$1 off admission coupon will be available. Registration forms will be mailed to past participants, and registration will also be available online.




When I drive that slow It's hard to steer And I can't take my car outta second gear What used to take 2 hours Now takes all day Huh It took me 16 hours to get to L.A.

Z Club 2009 Picnic


Saturday, July 11 Debbie Carlson

From either E470 or Lincoln Avenue, proceed south along Parker Road, Approximately 6 miles south of Mainstreet, you will come to the intersection of Parker Road and Bayou Gulch Road (this is the second intersection south of Pinery North). Ponderosa High School is on your left. Turn left and follow Bayou Gulch Road east for 3 miles. At Bayou Hills Road turn left (can't turn right) and go north ¼ mile. We are the yellow brick house with the green door on your right. You can park in the circle drive, on the garage pad or in the field.


