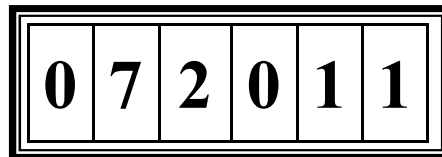

July 2011

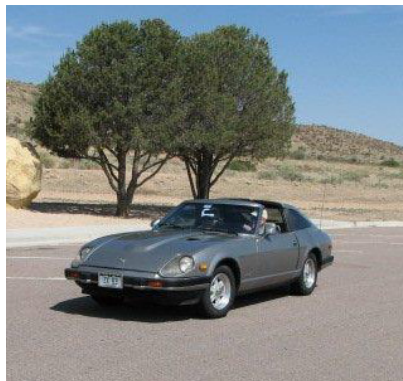

Driving directions: From the West and North (call for modifications if coming from the South or East) – Use whatever combination of I-25, 225, C470, E470 and Lincoln Avenue you choose to reach the town of Parker. From either E470 or Lincoln Avenue, proceed south along Parker Road. Approximately 6 miles south of Main street, you will come to the intersection of Parker Road and Bayou Gulch Road (this is the second intersection south of Pinery North). Ponderosa High School is on your left. Turn left and follow Bayou Gulch Road east for 3 miles. At Bayou Hills Road turn left (can't turn right) and go north ¼ mile. We are the yellow brick house with the green door on your right. You can park in the circle drive, on the garage pad or in the field.

While there are other places to eat lunch, I have always wanted to try one of these.

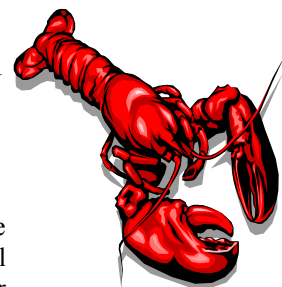
After lunch everyone will be on their own. You can either plan on a stay over night and take in the hot springs or head back to Denver.

To enter the Academy; please bring a picture ID, current registration, and insurance documents. Each vehicle is subject to inspection and search. No weapons are allowed.

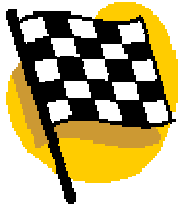

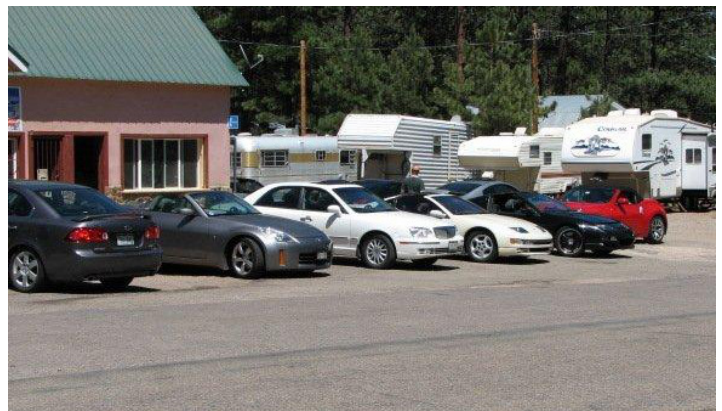

Recap of the Highway of Legends Drive on June 25 - 26, 2011

We met early at the SuperTarget in Lone Tree and despite my best efforts to have everyone ready to go at 8:45, someone (actually someone's) had to run to the bathroom just before we were going to leave. We started with 7 cars heading south and then picked up Ron and Carol south of Castle Rock and proceeded to lunch at George's in Walsenburg. The food was good and everyone seemed content with it.

Then to check in at the Rio Cucharas Inn on Hwy 160 on the way to La Veta. Someone had read a review that the "flies were fighting to get out of there" but fortunately it was a pretty nice place that the management is working to rehabilitate and is succeeding. The manager, Rawleigh, is quite a character with his strange hat and sparkly bowtie. The hotel has a very nice indoor pool that some of our 15 participants actually used and the continental breakfast on Sunday was far better than some of us were afraid it would be.

After check in and dumping our stuff in our rooms, we started our first run of Highway of Legends, Hwy 12, from La Veta to Trinidad. Tammy and I had run the highway from Trinidad to La Veta a couple of weeks before and knew that although the scenery going to Trinidad wasn't great, except for the stop at the Stonewall General Store with the huge rock dike across the road and the "house on the bridge", we knew it would be much better on the way back. My mistake in driving into Monument Lake which turned out to be a dusty dirt road wasn't the greatest move but everyone dealt with it well. Some of us managed some bonsai runs going south and we all made it to the coke ovens at Cokedale, about 10 miles from Trinidad. We had an extended break at the visitors center at Trinidad (no, no one stayed to check out Trinidad's specialty service) and then started the return run to La Veta. Some of us couldn't quite hold to the limit and everyone enjoyed the driving (once they got around the idiots) and scenery on the way back. After some clean up, we had a very nice but way too long of a meal at Alys Restaurant (no, I'm not kidding) in the La Veta Inn. The service was VERY slow but the food was very good. On Sunday, after a reasonable continental breakfast, some stayed at Rio Cucharas to swim and take I-25 home and others decided to just take I-25.
