The 2013 ZCCA convention will be held on August 5th – 9th in Nashua, New Hampshire.

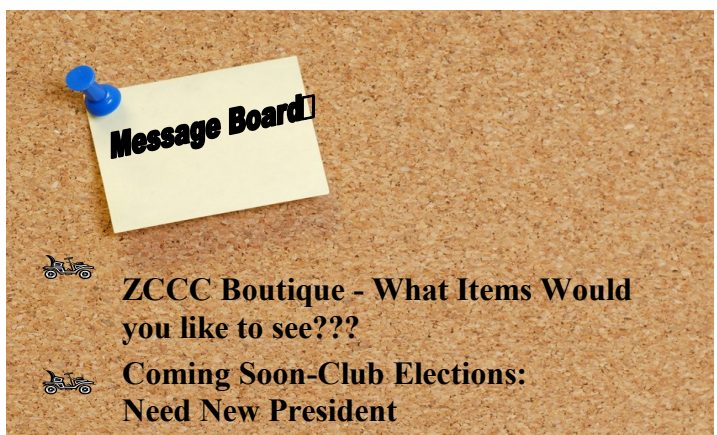
