

## September 11<sup>th</sup> at Second Creek Raceway by Gary Bracken

Our fall track event will be held September 11<sup>th</sup> at Second Creek Raceway -- a compelling 1.7 mile road course with 9 turns -- near Denver International Airport. If you've never had the opportunity to really open up your Z in a safe and controlled environment, here is your chance. Our track events, now in their 14<sup>th</sup> year, offer efficient organization, maximum bang for the buck, and one hour and twenty minutes of delightful time weaving your Z at speed through the sinewy turns of 2<sup>nd</sup> Creek's addictive tarmac. On top of that, you'll have a chance to compare notes about your car with other Z drivers. The camaraderie alone is sufficient reason to join us at 2<sup>nd</sup> Creek Raceway on September 11<sup>th</sup>!

There will be 4 different run groups: Novice (including first-timers), Experienced, Advanced and Expert. Driving experience and level of car preparation will determine your run group, and incar driving tips will be available from experienced drivers at no extra charge. Don't be intimidated -- this is not a wheel-to-wheel racing event. Instead, it is an opportunity to learn how to operate your Z more safely at higher speeds in a setting that is safe and fun.

All cars must pass a safety technical inspection, and each driver and passenger must wear approved clothing and a Snell-approved helmet (1995 or newer). If you are unfamiliar with technical inspection or clothing requirements, you may contact Roy Davis (303-445-3055; RDDAVIS@do.usbr.gov). We encourage you to have your car inspected BEFORE the track event. That way, you'll have time to correct any deficiencies that may surface during the inspection. Here are the inspection days/times: Sunday, August 29<sup>th</sup>, 1 to 4 p.m. at 2487 S. Dover Way, Lakewood, Colorado; Wednesday, September 8<sup>th</sup>, 4 to 6:30 p.m. at 2487 S. Dover Way, Lakewood, Colorado.

If you are unable to have your car inspected on either of these dates, you may have it teched at the track at 7:15 a.m. at 2<sup>nd</sup> Creek on September 11<sup>th</sup>



### Colorado State Patrol Track Event by Mike Goddard

It was a perfect day for the track event. The weather cooperated with us by being overcast, and not to hot. The only real complaint was the humidity. The event started at 08:00 AM. After the drivers, meeting the designated groups were on the track.

The unique configuration of the track allows for greater speeds but forces harder brake application. You are forced to rethink some of your driving habits. The overall experience is quite different from Second Creek Raceway, but every bit as much fun. During the event, a small herd of deer stopped in for a visit. They were not allowed to run on the track due to insurance and helmet restrictions.

As usual, there were no serious mishaps or incidents. The food was great and we made a profit. I think that all adds up to a pretty good event. As usual, the same people are out there helping.
