

Cops are sneaky, as if this comes as a surprise to all you guys.

On July 16, 2009 I was east bound on 6th Avenue at Broadway/Spear in Denver. I was in the Z and following a white van. 


To enter the Academy, please bring a picture ID, current registration, and insurance documents. Each vehicle is subject to inspection and search. No weapons are allowed.







The Straw Hat Celebration drew quite a few cars and track enthusiasts out to High Plains Raceway on August 1st.




