HOLIDAY PARTY AND TOYS FOR TOTS DRIVE

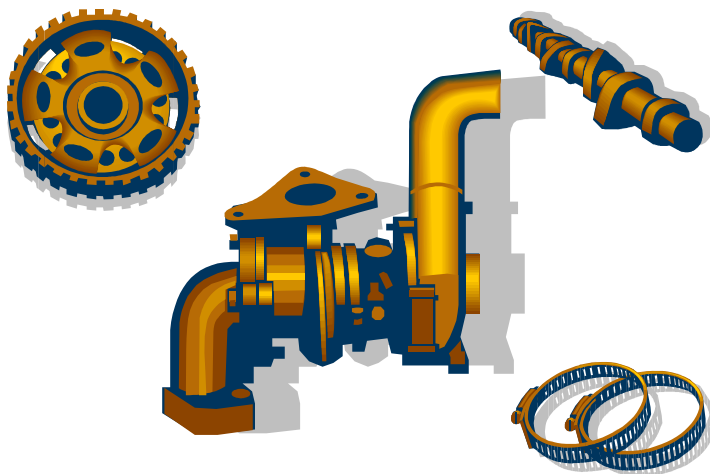

ZCCC History

In May that year (1985) Mary Snyder hosted a party to introduce new members to old ones. A game called "Nuts and Bolts" was played. The guys received a bolt (sizes varied) and the ladies received a nut (again sizes varied). The idea being, guys and ladies would mingle trying to match their parts. To ensure a good mingle, S.A.E. was mixed with metric. Who said car club parties were dull?

In June Leo Payne moved their dealership out to County line road so the new meeting place was moved to another Leo Payne at 300 Wadsworth. Membership #55 was issued then.

In July the Trans-Am Club invited the ZCCC to a day of fun and fast cars at Second Creek Race Track. We were invited back again later in the year.

New member Al Layer suggested that we think positive and instead award a "Clean Car Award" each month. He donated a traveling award just for that purpose. Al owned a Plymouth and I think he just joined the club because he found out how much fun we were having at all the great events.. A few months later the "Dirty Horn" conveniently became lost!

August 24 saw 19 smiling happy club members at the first Malibu Gran Prix event. My kids were too young to drive so they kept busy playing video games. Everyone watched each run and the best times for each car so they could pick the so called "fastest car" to do their runs in. When the so called "fastest car" was determined, the lines became long waiting for that car to come in. An employee of Malibu asked everyone what the slowest car there was. After a car was fingered for that dubious honor, that employee jumped in the car and turned the fastest times for the day! Members with the best times were awarded plaques, T-shirts and other prizes. The day was such a success that 30 people signed up for Malibu II. Afterwards a line of Z's screamed down I-25 to Keith Jones's place for a party.

Per our for sale section in the Odometer Newsletter, Bruce and Linda Carins announced that they are quitting the car business and selling all 14 Z-cars that they own at a discount. Boy that sure could make for a full garage!

On August 31 1985, thanks to Al Layer our new parade coordinator, 12 cars from ZCCC were in the Lakewood Parade.

In November the monthly meeting was moved to the Nissan Regional Headquarters located at 11000 E. 45th Ave. That was a fantastic place to have the meeting! A large room with a huge wooden table that everyone could sit around. We had hit the big time! The garage that was used to train the mechanics was so clean that it looked that you could eat off the floor! Membership 79 was issued them. The new club sponsor is Stevinson Nissan in Boulder.

March 15 1986, the ZCCC was in the Denver Saint Patrick's Parade for the first time thanks to Al Layer. I love parades and due to my Irish ancestry I try to make most of the Denver Saint Patrick's parades. I usually bring my three kids and sometimes their friends along. I would have loved to drive my '72 in that parade but it is orange and I do not think I would have gotten many people's positive attention but then who knows? I was especially proud to actually know a fine group of people namely the ZCCC as they passed by with their brightly decorated cars and warring green vests.

April 1986 the club issued its 101st membership.

December 1986 the ZCCC elected Bob Rapparlief beating out Mary Snyder 30 to 18 votes. The meeting time was changed from 7:30 to 7:00.

January 1987 membership #150 was given out and we have a new sponsor, Littleton Nissan (formally Reg Wylie Nissan).

November 1987 saw the new club logo unveiled thanks to Ben Millspaugh.
