PRESIDENT'S CORNER

Ah the sweet sweet smell of coolant. I'm sorry I missed seeing all of you at our last meeting my car overheated in traffic right by Mile High Stadium. After 2 failed attempts to get my car on a flatbed, I limped my way home shutting the engine down 3 times right before it hitting the high temperature mark and letting it cool back down. Fortunately this was the night of the first sleet/snowfall so at least it cooled down more quickly.

I limped my way up to the dealership on Thursday to see what they could find and ended up leaving it there overnight for a pressure test. Late the next day they determined the problem was a radiator fan that wasn't working. I asked if they tested the water pump and thermostat as well and they said yes. How much to replace the fan assembly? \$900 including the hour diagnostic they had done! So, I went out searching to see how much buying the part would be with our Z Club discount. I first tried Z Car Source and it was almost \$600 even with our discount. Then I found a 2006 350z being sold for parts in Commerce City. On my way over there I was about to pass an O'Reilly store and thought I should check it out to just to make sure. Their price was \$175 and that was before our commercial rate discount, new, had a warranty and it was more powerful than the OEM ones that are bound to fail. Done. 2 screws, move the hoses, unclip the two wiring clips for the fan and out came the old and in with the new.

Still overheating. I call Nissan again to confirm that they tested the thermostat because the lower radiator hose was still cool to the touch. They said yes they had tested it and wouldn't be able to get the car in for 4 days to retest to see what was going on.

At this point it's down to warped head (super expensive), water pump (mildly expensive), or the thermostat (relatively cheap and easy to replace).

I bought a block tester to see if it was a head problem as a Nissan mechanic in the VQ club said our engines can easily become shot if overheated since it's very easy to warp the aluminum. Yeah! The test was negative and the kit was a rental from Autozone and you get your deposit back. So while I was there returning the kit I figured I'd purchase a thermostat and just replace it for \$20.

So I removed 3 bolts and 2 hoses that are filled with coolant and the thermostat is crusty with green scale when I take it off. How do you test if your thermostat is stuck closed? Throw in it a big boiling pot of water on the stove with a new one. Sure enough the new one opened up right before the water boiled and the old one stayed closed. I wish I would have known this when I had the radiator fan assembly out so I had more room to work. Hoses reconnected, 3 bolts in, top it off with fluid, start it up and everything seems to work great. I go to back it out of the garage and notice the thermostat gasket is laying in front of the car. So, pull the thermostat off, drain, put on the gasket, thermostat, hoses, torque the bolts and I break the heads off 2 of them. Ugh! Now it's: take the thermostat back off and with a needle nose pliers back out the broken bolts. The local dealer doesn't have the parts so I have to run down to Mike Ward and get there 10 minutes before they close on Saturday. Ok, gasket, thermostat, hoses, bolts in, fill it up with fluid. No heat. Our engines are prone to getting bubbles trapped in the system so I spend much of the next day bleeding/burping the system with the car on an incline to force the bubbles to the top. I now have heat and the car is running normal again.

Well, I probably saved ~\$1,000 or so in the process of doing this myself. What was more valuable from the hours of YouTube instructional videos, forums, and other research I did is the knowledge of the entire cooling/heating system. At some point mechanical parts will fail like the thermostat and fans so I am super prepared for Stacey's car when this happens again and have the confidence to do it right the next time.


