PRESIDENT'S CORNER

This month I decided to take on a project that has been at least 10 years in the planning. I used to own an older Porsche (I know, it's not a Nissan) and considered putting a classic wooden steering wheel in. Fast forward to today. While researching what steering wheel is in the new Batman v Superman Batmobile (an upside down Ferrari F1), I ran across a couple of videos on how to do it on YouTube. I purchased the hub adapter and a new racing wheel and it actually was really easy to install. The kit I bought came with all of the wiring for the horn and the airbag. 2 bolts to remove, 1 nut to loosen/tighten back up, 5 wires to connect, 6 screws for the new wheel and it was mission accomplished! I wish I could say it was a 15 minute job (it should have been less) but I decided to video the process and did an extra step of DIY wiring that I ended up not having to do. As a side note: In Colorado if you don't swap your OEM steering wheel back (w/the airbag) when you go to have your car inspected they could fail you. If you *only* use your car at the track or do the drive-by emissions inspection you will be fine. This does delete your airbag and cruise controls so if you need either then this is not a project that you want to do. I plan on installing a 4 point harness in my car to replace the need for an airbag and rewiring the cruise controls (that I never use) into my shifter at some point.


When using South Santa Fe Dr. go South past the ACC Campus and turn right at the light onto Aspen Grove Parkway going West and the meeting place will be on your right.



DUTIES, BOARD OF DIRECTORS

<u>President:</u> 1. Preside at meetings of ZCCC and the Board; 2. Coordinate activities of the Board; 3. Call special meetings of the members and/or the Board; 4. Appoint committees and chairpersons as necessary; and 5. Arrange Meetings.

The President shall vote on matters for consideration by the Board only in case of a tie.

<u>Vice President:</u> 1. Preside at meetings of ZCCC and of the Board in the absence of the President; 2. Coordinate all events of the ZCCC; 3. Solicit and appoint members as specific event coordinators and/or committee members; 4. Generate and maintain a yearly calendar of events; and 5. Be responsible for maintaining an up-to-date list of activity points awarded to members.

<u>Secretary:</u> 1. Keep records of proceedings at official ZCCC meetings; and 2. Make reports to such organizations with which ZCCC may be affiliated as required.

<u>Treasurer:</u> 1. Have custody of all funds; 2. Pay expenditures on behalf of ZCCC in accordance with part III Section 1 of these By-Laws; 3. Give bond, at ZCCC expense, if required by the Board; 4. Receive and pay all debts on a timely basis upon approval of the President or another Board Member in the absence of the President, when receipts or other sufficient documentation for expenditure is attached; 5. Receive and pay all debts in the form of reimbursement to Club members within a reasonable time upon receipt of sufficient documentation; 6. Account to ZCCC quarterly by reporting to the Club through electronic means and upon request from the Board; and 7. Upon retirement from office turn over to the successor or to the President, all funds, books of accounts and any other ZCCC property in their possession.

Editor: 1. Be primarily responsible for the compilation, editing, production and distribution of the ZCCC newsletter to all eligible members; 2. Define deadlines for all information to be included in each edition of the newsletter; 3. Arrange for distribution in a timely fashion to all eligible members; and 4. Reciprocate with other Z Clubs by distributing to them the ZCCC newsletter.

<u>Inter-Club Liaison:</u> 1. Be the primary contact between the ZCCC and other car clubs; 2. Promote and coordinate joint events and/or ventures; 3. Maintain effective relations with the ZCCA as the ZCCA representative; 4. Be responsible for all communication between ZCCC and ZCCA; 5. Vote at ZCCA meetings; 6. Relay decisions of the ZCCC to the Association director; and 7. Submit ZCCC news to the ZCCA's newsletter and ZCCA's news to the ZCCC newsletter.

<u>Public Relations Officer:</u> 1. Generate and maintain the accuracy of the official list of businesses offering discounts to ZCCC members; 2. Promote favorable public relations and newspaper articles; and 3. Club sponsorships.

<u>Membership Officer:</u> 1. Maintain the membership database and communicate this information to necessary persons; 2. Issue renewal notices; and 3. Mail out membership cards and member packets promptly.
