PRESIDENT'S CORNER

Oh how 2 years and 9 months have flown by! We've come a long way as a club. First, the website. Some of these you might know, some might be a reminder they exist. What started as creating security for a protected member's-only section turned into: (1) Moving the website 3 times along the way (imagine packing up your entire house and moving) (2) Made 3 major updates (imagine painting your entire house - inside and outside), which has improved the speed of our site by 400%. (3) We now have a calendar system that also lists all of our events on Facebook as well. These local events can also be seen on Eventbrite which has resulted in some additional memberships. (4) On-line method to pay for events like the track, renewals, and new memberships. (5) On-line odometer ad submission and payment. (6) Complete archive of all of our past odometers. (6) Quick access to Active member point totals. (7) A faster membership directory/centralized membership information (before membership data existed in multiple places). (8) Membership cards are now available instantly online to print. (9) Online business directory which is searchable by the type of service members are looking for (Ira/Tammy used to manually

update this list *every* month in the odometer). (10) If someone registers as a new member online they immediately have access to membership benefits.

Updated processes for the club:

New members sending in checks for new registrations and renewals now have faster processing due to electronic deposit vs. what could have taken up to a 1 ½ months to process in the past. The board used to have to get general membership approval for most expenditures, now the board can approve most items up to \$1,000. Elimination of Google Groups/Blasts that used to allow anyone to send e-mails (no matter the subject matter) to the entire club. ZCCC board conference calls - we used to have to fight through traffic to get to board meetings on time and try getting 8 people from every direction to get there. Eliminated 80% of mailed newsletters.







Vote on Change to Constitution -

Section 2 - Points

Members receive points as follows:

- 1. Attending a sanctioned event.
 - i. Attending a one day event -1 point
 - ii. Attending a multi-day event 1 point for each day attended.
- 2. Hosting or organizing a sanctioned event.
 - i. Hosting or organizing a one day event 4 points
 - ii. Hosting or organizing a multi-day event 4 points for the first day of the event and one (1) point for each additional day hosting that event.
 - iii. A member hosting or organizing an event with another member(s) may split the 4 points. The Vice President must be advised of the points division at the time the event is being held or when the sign-in sheet is turned into the Vice President.
 - iv. Member(s) hosting or organizing an event do not receive additional points for attending the event except as noted above.
- 3. A point is only received by signature on the event and meeting sign-in sheet for a sanctioned event.
- 4. Points are only awarded to members in good standing.
- 5. In the case of a dispute over point eligibility, the Vice President will make the final decision.
