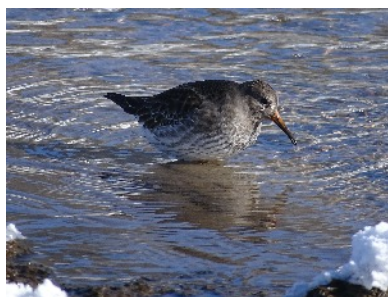

With blue sky above, Florissant Fossil Beds National Monument proved an interesting window into the area's geologic history. Saturday morning greeted us with cold temperatures and a blanket of fresh fallen snow. Great Sand Dunes National Park and Preserve greeted us with a short lived blizzard and no traffic.
