

Like the last year, it will be an evening game with dinner included. Here are the specifics, including the meeting place and time.



USING THE ZCCC WEBSITE & FACEBOOK

Guide to the ZCCC WEBSITE/FACEBOOK

To get to the website go to www.zccc.org

What can I see from the main page? You can see the calendar with upcoming events, button shortcuts, and the most recent odometer, as well as the login page

How do I login to the Member's only part of the website?

- 1. Scroll to the very bottom of the webpage
- 2. On the bottom left hand side of the page you'll see a place to enter your username and password. Enter your username and Password (if unsure send an email to Tom or try clicking "Forgot Password")

What can I do under the member tab at the top of the webpage?

- 1. I can renew my membership (there is a small processing fee)
- 2. I can check out my Active Member Points
- 3. I can look at the club directory
- 4. And more...

How do I check out the Odometer?

- 1. Click directly on the tab labeled "Odometer" located at the top of the webpage
- 2. Then look for the Odometer you want to read
- 3. On that Odometer click "continue reading"
- 4. Then click on the year_month (example: 2017_03)

Guide to the ZCCC Facebook Page

How do I check out the page without signing in or having an account?

- 1. Go to https://www.facebook.com/ZCarClubOfColorado/
- 2. From there you can see recent updates and postings

How do I like and follow the club's Facebook Page?

- 1. Go to www.facebook.com

- 3. In the top left hand corner look for something that says "Search Facebook"
