There will be some incidental costs but compared to what we thought we would have to spend, the expense should be minimal. However, if we run into unforeseen problems with the existing site, we may still have to develop a new site but at this time it appears unlikely. Those of you who were at the December meeting were asked to fill out a questionnaire as to what you thought of the existing website. You were asked what features we should keep and what to get rid of. Here are some of the results: Eventbrite is very unpopular and a substantial number would like the site to be more user friendly and easier to use. Some of the existing features are popular and we will be improving them and keeping them. The process of developing the new site will be ongoing and flexible and the Board is looking forward to input from the


