PRESIDENT'S CORNER



All I want for Christmas....

Today is day 49 of the Batmobile being in for repairs. The good news is that they've actually started. I asked the son of the shop on Monday, "Do you know the one gift I want for Christmas? My car back." This was before the shock of my OEM reverse/turn signal lights not mounting in the aftermarket bumper properly. Their initial solution was to cut the old bumper for the holes that fit, cut the new bumper, and fiberglass the pieces together (all for the tune of \$\$\$). I didn't like breaking a new part for a duct tape type fix so I came up with another plan. Thank goodness I ordered non-oem tail lights as it has an extra bulb in each to become a turn signal. I also had a spare set of led light bars that I was going to mount on the front of the car which will be wired up as my super bright reverse lights. Another crisis and 6 hour labor delay averted.

On top of this, while I was taking Stacey to work today in her 350z, the car the Service Engine Soon, traction control, and slip light all came on at the same time. When it rains it pours. I turned off the car and it took a long time to crank over. I'm late for work and my diagnostic tool is in the Batmobile, in the shop. I stop in quick and the whole back end is still off the car. "We should have all the wiring done and the parts mounted on the car today," the son of the shop owner tells me as I'm pulling my ODB2 bluetooth connector. I had to run out of there so I didn't strangle everyone in my path.

PRESIDENT'S CORNER (continued)

Thank goodness for this \$17 part. I have an app on my phone called Torque that connects to this device that plugs into your OBD2 port under the driver's side almost directly below the fuel filler cap release. When you fire up the app you can read the error codes. In this case (03-07 350z owners take note as this most likely will happen to you) it listed P0340 - Powertrain Camshaft Position Sensor "A" circuit bank 1. Hmm, this has already happened to the Batmobile. The sensor is prone to having oil seep into the plastic housing and crack the sensor over time. It's about a 15 minute removal of a plug and replace. If you have any car later than 2000 I highly suggest picking up the OBD2 bluetooth connector (~\$17 eBay) and the app for your phone (~\$6). I knew exactly what was wrong before going to fix the problem. It has a very detailed explanation of the problem in plain English. It's also saved us a couple times for silly errors like your gas cap not being tightened fully and having a Gross emissions system failure code be triggered. Normally you'd have to go to the dealer to clear the code. With the app you can clear the code with a press of a button.
