



- Welding nut trick: I'm please to provide an update that it does indeed work on steel on steel.
- If you happen to rebuild the T3 turbo from the 280zx and 300zx (Z31), you can align the center section to the exhaust housing using the oil drain tube and fins. The compressor housing can be aligned using the notch for the bolt on the oil drain tube. Learn from my pain:-) I now have lots of reference photos if someone needs them -- Jason Spegal
