National Museum of World War II Aviation Visit – July 15, 2023 RECAP BY: ANDY MORTENSON

We met at Cabela's sporting goods at 9:00 on Saturday morning and proceeded to Colorado Springs and the National Museum of World War II Aviation. We arrived in time to take the 10:30 tour, but due to the size of our group (there were 22 of us in all) they added an extra tour at 11:00 with our own docent. The tour started in the new hangar which contains about a dozen aircraft ranging from a prewar F3F "Flying Barrel" biplane fighter all the way up to an F7F Tigercat fighter developed at the war's end. They have nearly doubled the size of their collection since we were last there in 2019. Our docent provided the history of each aircraft and its role in helping win the conflict. We then proceeded across the ramp to WestPac Restorations, a premier World War II aircraft restoration and maintenance facility. There we saw several war birds that they had previously restored plus one undergoing restoration, a Navy SB2C Helldiver, which will be one of only two airworthy Helldivers in the world. The docent pointed out that all the airplanes on display are airworthy and perform at air shows.

We had originally planned to have lunch at the nearby "Airplane" restaurant following the tour. However, most of the group headed home due to thunderstorms in the area. I think everyone enjoyed the tour and I thank everyone for attending.

This will make all of our jobs so much easier.


