#### TRADITIONAL CHRISTMAS COOKIES

#### **INGREDIENTS**

- 2 cups all purpose flour
- 2 tsp cream of tartar
- 1 tsp baking soda
- 1 tsp ground nutmeg
- 1 pinch ground cinnamon
- 1 cup butter softened
- 1 cup white sugar
- 3 eggs, beaten
- 1 tsp vanilla extract

#### **FROSTING**

4 cups confectioners sugar 1/2 cup softened butter 1 tbs vanilla extract 1/2 cup milk 2 drops any food coloring



Make overnight and refrigerate. Preheat oven to 350 degrees F (175 degrees C). Roll out dough on floured surface to 1/2 inch thick. Cut into shapes with Christmas cookie cutters. Place cookies 1 inch apart on ungreased cookie sheets. Bake in the preheated oven until the edges are golden, 8 to 10 minutes. Let cool and frost.

Tom attended ZCON and entered his car in the Judged Car Show. He took second place in the Stock 280ZX division.








FACEBOOK MYSTERY 280 Z IN POLAND




