

2024 Nissan Z: What's New

Nissan introduced the latest in its line of Z sports cars for the 2023 model year and has now debuted a high-performance NISMO variant for 2024. Offered with a 3.0-liter, twin-turbocharged V-6 engine mated exclusively with a nine-speed automatic transmission, the Nissan Z NISMO cranks out 420 hp and 384 lb-ft of torque. Those figures represent an improvement of 20 hp and 34 lb-ft of torque over the standard model.

Other NISMO-specific upgrades include model-specific bodywork and styling, beefier brakes, a retuned suspension setup, a more rigid body, and grippier tires. Inside, there's a steering wheel with leather and Alcantara trim, complemented by red switchgear and special digital display graphics as well as Recaro seats embellished with NISMO logos. Additionally, all NISMO models receive built-in Amazon Alexa connectivity, a feature shared with the Nissan Z Performance trim as of the 2024 model year.

Car Posting the Biggest Gains in a Slow Market

1970-1972 Nissan Fairlady Z 432 +48%

Most car enthusiasts know the Datsun 240Z, but far fewer know the Nissan Fairlady Z 432. That lack of awareness hasn't hindered values, though. The car surged in price by 48 percent to close the year, and one in excellent condition now costs a hair below \$300,000.

The Z 432 is a performance variant of the original Z car produced for the Japanese domestic market and features a close-ratio five-speed transmission, dual exhaust, a limited-slip rear differential, and a sportier suspension. Most importantly, though, it is powered by the same four-valve, three-carb, dual-overhead cam S20 engine that propelled the legendary Prince R380, Japan's first purpose-built prototype racer (see image below). The 432 is exceedingly rare, too, with only around 420 built.

Given their rarity and the devotion of their owners, these cars change hands infrequently, but an excellent example found a new owner at Mecum's Monterey auction last August for \$297,000. This public benchmark is consistent with reported private sales activity for perfect cars soaring above \$400,000. Furthermore, the Nissan "Hakosuka" Skyline 2000GT-R also had a strong quarter, with their price guide values increasing by 13 percent. This is proof that JDM fans are as interested in the older back catalog as they are in more modern models.


