

Nissan is taking the new Z racing. They just revealed a brand-new Nissan Z GT500 race car at Fuji Speedway in Japan, which the firm says will compete in the Japan-only Super GT racing series beginning next year. The car looks wicked—the classic lines that have us adoring the production Z are still there, but now there are box flares, dive planes, and a honking rear wing on the back. GT500 is the quicker of the two classes in the Super GT series, with GT300 being the slower one. GT500 cars have far more downforce than their GT300 counterparts, which helps them turn much quicker lap times.


