The General Membership will vote on these three proposed changes to the ZCCC Constitution at the July General Meeting"... The proposed changes are highlighted in yellow.

Section 2 - Vice-President

The Vice-President shall:

- 1. In the absence of the President, preside at meetings of ZCCC and of the Board
- 2. Coordinate all events of the ZCCC
- 3. Solicit and appoint members as specific event coordinators
- 4. Generate and maintain a yearly calendar of events
- 5. Be responsible for maintaining an up-to-date list of activity points awarded to members
- 6. Determine the number of points awarded for multi-day events
- 7. Determine who "owns" an event (i.e. the member entitled to sponsor a specific event)
- 8. Determine if events are conflicting in time or activities
- 9. Be responsible for acquiring and distributing the Active Member Awards and the Most Active Member Award(s). Expenditure for these awards shall be approved by the Board.
- 10. Upon retiring from this position, the Vice-President shall deliver to their successor, or the President, all records and information in their possession necessary to facilitate the smooth transition of the duties of Vice President to their successor. Additionally, the retiring Vice-President shall pass on to their successor or the President all information in their possession necessary to facilitate the

Current ZCCC Constitution wording:

Active Member Award: A ZCCC member is eligible for an active member award if they accumulate 15 or more points in a fiscal year.

To provide the Vice President enough time to order Active Member Awards with the goal of having them available for distribution at the Annual Banquet early October...

Proposed ZCCC Constitution change:

Active Member Award: A ZCCC member is eligible for an active member award if they accumulate 15 or more points between September 1st of any year and August 31st of the following year.

Earthic year only 2022, Members acquiring points in September will be given the chains of applying

For this year only, 2022, Members acquiring points in September will be given the choice of applying them to this year's points or applying them to their 2023 points.

CONTITUTIONAL CHANGES CONTINUED

Proposal: Eliminate the position of Sergeant-at-Arms. Assign the duties of Sergeant-at-Arms as defined in Roberts Rules of Order to the Constitution Analyst.

Add the Sergeant-at-Arms duties from Roberts Rules of Order to the Constitution Analyst as listed below:

Acts as a doorkeeper, maintains order at the direction of the presiding officer, and is responsible for the comfort of the assembly.

Reason: The Sergeant-at-Arms position has been vacant for several years. The Constitution Analyst has access to direction and procedures as outlined in Roberts Rules of Order at all times.

Proposed Change:

Constitution Analyst: Will help the Board interpret the Constitution and By-Laws. Advise the Board on questions about the Constitution and By-Laws. The Constitution Analyst will be the person who makes revisions to the Constitution and By-Laws as directed by the Board or by the President in certain situations. The Constitution Analyst and the President will have an editable version of the Constitution and By-Laws. All other ZCCC members can see only a secured PDF version.

Acts as a doorkeeper, maintains order at the direction of the presiding officer, and is responsible for the comfort of the assembly.

MEET YOUR MEMBER MATT McDOLE

I was born and raised in Tucson, AZ. After earning a Civil Engineering degree there I pursued a career in design and construction of transportation projects in Arizona, California and Colorado. This took me on relocations from Tucson to San Francisco to LA back to San Francisco to Denver back to San Francisco again and finally back to Denver in 1995. I retired 3 years ago.

How I obtained my 1972 240Z is a story. Living in San Francisco in late 1971, my "65 Chevy Impala Super Sport Coupe was stollen and found completely stripped. I was in need of new wheels. Looking at the new Detroit Iron offerings I found nothing to my satisfaction. Then I recalled a few months back at the Pebble Beach, Bing Crosby golf tournament a neat yellow sports car drove up to the valet stand. I recognized the driver when he got out. It was Rick Barry, the 6'7" pro basketball star. Sports car cabins I had experienced were tight for me but I thought that if that 6'7" guy could fit in that car, my 6'3" frame could. Of course. The car was a 240Z. So I visited some Datsun dealers, but all the 71s were sold and no 72s had arrived as there was a dock strike and they couldn't get cars in from Japan. I did find a '71 Z on a used car lot, drove it and decided I wanted a Z. I thought the strike couldn't last too long so I put down a deposit and ordered a new Z. I also got on wait lists at other dealers. I was wrong about the strike – It lasted 6 months. By early summer '72 240Zs started to trickle in to dealers. Similar to what I saw recently. Dealers took advantage of the high demand /low supply situation and required premiums increasing the price. Also dealers add on options like air conditioning for \$500. So, a \$4100 base price could easily escalate to \$5000. That was lot for me in 1972. By mid June I got a few calls from dealers but the high prices and color were not acceptable. My preference was for a brown or green car. Then a dealer from Modesto called with a brown Z, but I couldn't swallow the premiums. (looking back I wish I would have). Mid July the dealer with my deposit called with a red Z with no premiums. I took it and picked it up at the San Jose dealer on my 33rd birthday. What a great birthday present!

The first five years this 240Z was my only vehicle including 1 1/2 winters in Denver. After parking lot dings and general wear I had the car painted brown, my original first choice. I Also had the interior redone in brown. That's how it is today. I've managed to hang on to the Z for 50 years through marriage (41 years to Sandi) and 2 kids. I'm delighted to still have it!

I joined ZCCC in 2006, I believe. I enjoy the fellowship and the great variety of events. I participate as in much as I can ,mixed in with other interest and activities including family, travel ,model railroading and attending sports events. A big thing right now is our 18-month-old granddaughter who we care for frequently. I am looking forward to hosting the Gateway Classic Cars Caffeine And Chrome Car Show on August 27, 2022. It should be a lot of fun with a huge turn out.







The National Museum of World War II Aviation in Colorado Springs documents the role that military aviation played in the emergence of our nation as a world power during the Second World War. Through a combination of its aircraft collection and other exhibits, the museum tells the story of our nation's tremendous technological advancements during the war that were essential to the success of the Allied war effort.

The museum displays a wide array of fully restored aircraft that represent all aspects of America's involvement in World War II. Most of the aircraft are meticulously restored to flying condition, and many are flown at air shows. (For those who shared our visit to the museum back in 2019, the new hangar has since been completed and many aircraft that were in storage are now on display.) The visit also includes the WestPac Restorations facility which is adjacent to the museum.

WestPac Restorations is a premier World War II aircraft restoration and maintenance facility. WestPac is a highly specialized FAA-certified repair station that includes paint facilities, a prop shop, and a full service metal forming shop. WestPac has been closely affiliated with the museum since its inception, and allows public access to its facility through the museum's docent-led tour program.

We plan to take the 10:30 AM tour which includes WestPac Restorations. We'll meet at Cabela's sporting goods located on the southwest side of the intersection of

I-25 and Ridgegate Parkway in Lone Tree. We'll leave at 9:00 AM and convoy down to the museum which is located on the south side of Colorado Springs. Please note that there is an admission fee of \$17.00 for adults and \$15.00 for seniors. The guided tour costs an additional \$5.00. While the tour isn't required, it's highly recommended.

As an optional extension to the museum visit for us aviation junkies, lunch will be available at "The Airplane" restaurant adjacent to the Radisson Hotel which is near the museum. The restaurant is built in and around a 1950's era Air Force KC-97 Stratotanker airplane like the one flown by ZCCC member Steve Robertson.


