For those interested in a new subscription of this amazing magazine for 2021, please contact Jason Spegal for a pro-rated price from the full price of \$21.50 (\$13.50 for the subscription + \$8.00 for direct mailing to your mailbox). Payment options for new subscriptions will be by check only at this time. If this is an issue please contact Jason Spegal to work out other options.


