New Business:


None currently. The 50/50 drawing went to Mark Johnson. The meeting adjourned at 9:06 pm.

BIZARRECOLORADO

Cano's Castle (Antonito) A tall castle constructed entirely of empty beer cans and other recycled materials.

Bishop Castle (Rye)

This elaborate and intricate roadside attraction in south-central Colorado was built, stone by stone, over several decades. This is one incredible site to see.

Tiny Town (Morrison) This town is comprised of tiny homes, buildings and other replicas. Largest Fork in the U.S. (Creede) A 600 pound fork not to be missed.

Mike the Headless Chicken (Fruita)

This approximately 5-foot tall statue is a reminder of the rooster named Mike that lived without a head for almost 2 years (April 20, 1945 – March 17, 1947).

World's most expensive GT-R?

A regular old Skyline GT-R isn't special, you say? It's not rare enough, powerful enough, or even expensive enough? Well, the time for excuses is over. Collecting Cars announced that it will be offering the last known R33-generation NISMO 400R. Currently residing in the U.K., this Skyline GT-R could become one of the most expensive Japanese cars ever sold at auction. A blue-chip collector vehicle that is rarely seen at public auction, the 400R has been widely considered to be the ultimate factory GT-R. Stuffed with tech from Nissan's Le Mans program, the 400R is dripping in carbon fiber and titanium and propelled by a 2.8-liter, twin-turbo straight-six engine that makes 400 horsepower, supercar-level power for the mid-1990s. Just 40 were built, which means these have the perfect combination of lore and rarity to easily become seven-figure automobiles. The catch? Unless you're a dealer, the ability to bid or even to know the final price of a 400R is extremely limited. In fact, one recently auctioned crashed the bidding system when the bid exceeded the system's numerical limits; final bidding was conducted privately, however the reported sale was over \$1.1 million. A second, the only Champion Blue example built, sold for an undisclosed amount, reportedly smashing that record.

The fact that a 400R is being offered at all is a big deal, and the fact that it is being offered for public auction—rather than private sale—outside of Japan is an even bigger one. Since this very car was offered for sale last year at Harlow-Jap-Autos (HJA) with an asking price of \$2.2 million, it's guaranteed that if this car meets reserve, it will be well past the \$1 million mark. The bigger question is how high it will go.





DENVER RACING SIM

Be prepared for a thrilling event on June 10th. Andrew Woodward of Denver Racing Sim (formerly Elevated Racing Club, or ERC) is inviting ZCCC members to experience the kind of car racing most of us can only dream about. <u>Ten members</u> will experience a free 10-minute session in his racing simulator which will be pre-programmed with the classic 5 speed Nissan GTP ZX-T at Laguna Seca race, his personal recommendation for our club. The start time is 10am and will end at 12:30pm. This is a private event for ZCCC members so be sure to have your membership card/image available. Members can bring one non-demo driving guest. Due to the complexity of the simulator and equipment, the minimum age for the event is 18 years. Waivers will need to be signed by all in attendance. **Sim time will be given to members who sign up using the registration link below**. If you signed up in October, you need to sign up again using the link. *Please register early*. When the maximum number of registrants is reached, the software will disable the ability to register. No cutoff date to register. Club members can spectate without time in the simulator.

Registration Link: <u>https://DenverRacingSim.as.me/ZCCC</u>, scroll down and click on date, click on continue, then fill out the form, etc. Everyone will need to be at Andrew's location, 747 Sheridan Blvd, Unit 5D, Lakewood, CO 80214, at 10am. Andrew will get members in the sim in order of arrival, not booking time. There is a comfortable lounge and simulator room where you can talk with everyone or watch and wait for your turn. The club will furnish muffins. Please bring your own coffee, tea, water, soda, etc.

*The building's location is on the West side of Sheridan. The driveway goes up hill and comes to a T as it approaches the building. At the T go left and follow the road to the back of the building. Units are well labeled. Ample parking available.

For those of you who are unfamiliar with it, autocross is a timed competition held on flat, paved surfaces with few obstructions such as parking lots or airport tarmacs in which drivers navigate one at a time through a defined course marked by traffic cones.

Autocross courses place the demands on car handling and driver skill rather than on engine power and outright speed. It emphasizes safe competition and active participation.

Since rubber traffic cones define the course, the hazards are low. The speeds are typically not as great as those encountered in legal highway driving, but the combination of concentration and precision maneuvering gives drivers an experience similar to that of a full road course race.

Some of you will remember the autocross event we held at the Adams County Sheriff's Department Training Center in Commerce City last summer and how much fun it was.

Well, we've scheduled another autocross for the morning of Saturday, June 17th. The event will again be held at the Adams County Sheriff's Department Training Center in Commerce City. The facility is located at 23600 East 128th Avenue which is about 5 miles east of Barr Lake.

We'll be using their nice smooth 3 ¼ acre skill pad for our autocross. We have rented the pad for four hours, from 8:00 AM until Noon. We're going to limit participation to the first 20 cars to register because we'd like to guarantee each car a minimum of three timed runs through the course during that time. There will be a charge of \$20.00 for each member and \$30.00 for non-members. Please bring cash or a check payable to ZCCC because credit cards can't be accepted.

Helmets will be required and the Training Center requires that a release form be signed by each participant. The center is in a treeless area and there is no shade so bring sun protection and drinking water. There are bathroom facilities within easy walking distance. Please save the date and come on out and watch the fun even if you don't plan to participate.

Note: The event has now been opened to the public because we only had a handful of members signed up to participate. We now have 13 people on the list which is approaching the 20 car limit. So, you better sign up while you still can.

The National Museum of World War II Aviation in Colorado Springs documents the role that military aviation played in the emergence of our nation as a world power during the Second World War. Through a combination of its aircraft collection and other exhibits, the museum tells the story of our nation's tremendous technological advancements during the war that were essential to the success of the Allied war effort.

The museum displays a wide array of fully restored aircraft that represent all aspects of America's involvement in World War II. Most of the aircraft are meticulously restored to flying condition, and many are flown at air shows. (For those who shared our visit to the museum back in 2019, the new hangar has since been completed and many aircraft that were in storage are now on display.) The visit also includes the WestPac Restorations facility which is adjacent to the museum.

WestPac Restorations is a premier World War II aircraft restoration and maintenance facility. WestPac is a highly specialized FAA-certified repair station that includes paint facilities, a prop shop, and a full service metal forming shop. WestPac has been closely affiliated with the museum since its inception, and allows public access to its facility through the museum's docent-led tour program.

We plan to take the10:30 AM tour which includes WestPac Restorations. We'll meet at Cabela's sporting goods located on the southwest side of the intersection of

I-25 and Ridgegate Parkway in Lone Tree. They have a huge parking lot so let's meet in the northeast corner. We'll leave at 9:00 AM and convoy down to the museum which is located on the south side of Colorado Springs. Please note that there is an admission fee of \$17.00 for adults and \$15.00 for seniors. The guided tour costs an additional \$5.00. While the tour isn't required, it's highly recommended.

As an optional extension to the museum visit for us aviation junkies, lunch is available at "The Airplane" restaurant adjacent to the Radisson Hotel which is near the museum. The restaurant is built in and around a 1950's era Air Force KC-97 Stratotanker airplane like the one flown by ZCCC member Steve Robertson.
