LETTER FROM YOUR EDITOR BROUGHT TO YOU BY THE LETTER "C"







Summer is one of the most beautiful seasons to visit Hoosier Pass (pictures below). Our trip will begin in Denver, taking Hwy. 285 (Hampden) west to the town of Fairplay, elevation 9,953 ft. Travel time is 2 hrs. Lunch will be at Mr. Burro Café, see above link. There is ample off-street parking and eat-in dining. After lunch we will take State Hwy. 9 through the town of Alma and begin our ascent to the summit of Hoosier Pass (named after the settlers from Indiana).





Montgomery Reservoir

After spending time at the summit, we will descend Hoosier Pass and continue to Breckenridge. The descent becomes hairpin curves, some at 8% grade, which level out as we get close to Breckenridge. Spending time in Breckenridge is optional. You can shop, take a gondola ride, or stay overnight. If visiting Breckenridge is not on your schedule, at Hoosier summit, take State Highway 9 back to Fairplay, and your route of choice home. If you want to return to Denver from Breckenridge, take State Highway 9 to Frisco and I70 east to Denver.

We are going to explore one of Colorado's largest collection of military, space and civilian aircraft. Our drive will be via I25 to Pueblo. The Museum opens at 10am. This will be a self-guided tour so you can explore the museum at your own pace. There are two hangers and outdoor exhibits that span over 85,000 square feet. The Pueblo Weisbrod Aircraft Museum is a non-profit museum owned by the City of Pueblo and managed by the Pueblo Historical Aircraft Society. The Museum was built on the historic site of the Pueblo Army Air Base, one of the largest heavy bomber training bases in World War II. Six major bomb groups trained there and would ultimately be assigned to the Mighty 8th Air Force. Major Clark Gable trained with the 351st Bomber Group. The Museum is adjacent to the Pueblo Memorial Airport. Parking is free, first come first served. Restrooms are located inside each hangar. The hangars are cooled with large ceiling fans and not fully air-conditioned. The Gift Shop is fully air-conditioned. A motorized wheelchair is available. Handicapped parking is available. There is ample seating throughout each hanger and a paved sidewalk connects the two hangars. Visit the Museum website https://pwam.org for additional information. Nissan Develops DOHC Head for S30 Z

To celebrate NISMO's 40th anniversary, Nissan unveiled a gorgeous S30-generation Z with an impressive jewel of engineering bolted between the fenders. The car and its fabulous engine debuted at the Nostalgic 2Days 2024 show in Yokohama. Its L-series inline-six engine now displaces 3.0 liters and is topped by a DOHC cylinder head developed by Nissan. The added displacement helped boost torque output, while the massively improved breathing from the four-valve head allows the engine to rev to 7,500rpm and produce more than 300 horsepower in the process. That's more than double the 2.4-liter Lseries that was originally found in the 240Z!

There are just two problems with the new cylinder head. First, according to The Drive, Nissan isn't selling it to any intrepid builders who want the ultimate top-end for their restomod classic Z. At least not yet. Second, the RB engine family, which replaced the L family of Nissan inline-six engines, already has a DOHC cylinder head and a ton of performance potential, as seen in the legendary Skyline. Nissan teased that this cylinder head could be made available, but the price might be prohibitively expensive at the small volumes that this niche market would support, especially considering the existence of the aforementioned factory DOHC Nissan engines.

Of course, we're not faulting Nissan for building this unique cylinder head. It's a great homage to the beautiful S30 Z, and it blends characteristics from Nismo's 40 years of inline-six performance heritage into a single engine in a way that a simple engine swap would not have. Nissan is also helping owners of some of its classic cars by manufacturing parts that are otherwise hard to find. We just can't help but wonder why they'd show this head if they didn't plan to offer it up for sale eventually. Quit teasing us, Nissan. SEMA 2024 is just seven months away, and that would be the perfect place to show us a production version of this head along with an exhaust header and a pair of intake manifolds, one for those who prefer carbs and another for those who'd rather use fuel injection. Hey, an inline-six fan can dream.
