

The Z-Car "Holy Grail" Headlines This Ultimate Datsun and Nissan Collection

Motortrend - Mecum Auctions will feature the ultimate historic collection of vintage Nissan sports cars.



We've encountered countless Datsun Z-car fanatics over the years, some with all-original examples that, 50 years after production, are still alive and kicking. We've also seen plenty of deep dive restorations that completely renew these aging Japanese classics, giving them a new lease on life. Despite that, we've never encountered a collection as complete and historic as Mike and Debbie Rogers' impeccable ensemble. Mike's obsession with Datsun's curvy, front-engine, rear-wheel-drive sports car began at a young age as he encountered multiple Zs that his father would source and rebuild at his shop. After finishing his day at high school, Mike would head straight to his father's garage to help work on them and, in turn, educated himself on the car's inner and outer workings. Those early days stuck with him, and his meticulously curated collection would grow into an eight chassis stable complete with low-mileage gems, anniversary editions, restorations, and even a JDM "holy grail."

1969 Datsun 240Z

There were a little more than 500 240Zs produced in 1969, and of that bunch less than 200 exist today, according to <u>the zhome registry</u>. This is one of them, and it's in immaculate condition currently, but it wasn't always that way. Mike spent eight long years carefully restoring it. When he reached the limit of his abilities, he passed the car to his friend and Z-car guru, Rob Fuller of Z Car Garage, who added the finishing touches.

1970 Nissan Fairlady Z432

One of the holy grails of Z-car collecting, this Japanese domestic market (JDM) Z432 is one of just 299 produced between 1969 and 1970. Originally restored in London, then restored once again in Japan, this numbers-matching, right-hand-drive model is draped in delicious orange with a slick black interior. Its iconic Watanabe magnesium wheels and fender-mounted mirrors are what most Z-car builders have on their todo list.

1972 Datsun 240Z

In the mid-'90s, Nissan purchased multiple 240Zs and using OEM parts from overseas, had them completely restored, and even supplied them with modern warranties. Made available through select dealers, the dream scenario for some didn't result in a huge demand from enthusiasts.

1977 Datsun 280Z ZZZAP Edition

In an effort to offer a new look to the Z in 1977, Nissan introduced the ZZZAP model with around 1,000 Sunburst Yellow versions adorned with colorful graphics on both sides of the car and a stripe that ran down the center of the hatch, roof, and most of the hood. Its advertising campaign slogan screamed, "The Z with more ZZZAP!"

1978 Datsun 280Z Black Pearl Edition

Unlike some of the high-dollar and time-intensive restorations in the Rogers collection, this low-mileage model is all-original with around 61,000 miles accumulated. Dubbed the Black Pearl Edition, it's the very first Z-car to be covered in black and the last to use a Z with its name, rather than the upcoming ZX line, which would carry on for a few generations before converting back to the single letter.

1980 Datsun 280ZX 10th Anniversary

By 1978, the Z-car reached a decade of greatness and to celebrate, a 10th anniversary edition was released of which 2,500 were offered in black and gold, while only 500 were made available in red and black. 1,250 U.S. Datsun dealers would be allocated a gold/black Z, but only the top 500 were blessed with a red/ black version.

1983 Nissan 200ZX Turbo

The '80s brought forth substantial change for the Z-car, including a larger, more sophisticated chassis that moved away from what Nissan called a "personal sporting GT car" into a grand touring model. The additional weight was offset to some degree with the introduction of a turbocharger applied to what would be the final I-6 for the Z-car family forever.

1984 Nissan 300ZX Turbo 50th Anniversary

Nissan celebrated its golden anniversary with 5,000 of their 50th anniversary edition 300ZX for U.S. buyers. The redesign stepped further away from the styling of the 240/60/80Z of the past and maintained the larger frame and amenity-packed interior. It also introduced unique, half-exposed pop-up headlights. The Rogers Z-car collection heads to Mecum Auctions' Monterey event taking place August 17-19, 2023.

8 things Nissan changed for the new Z Nismo

Nissan's in-house performance division, Nismo, has a long history of tuning the automaker's road cars, guided by lessons learned in racing. Mind you, Nismo doesn't usually hot-rod an existing vehicle in the same way that Shelby amps up Ford's Mustang, starting by yanking out the base engine for one with 60 percent more horsepower. Though the Nismo version of the 2024 Z is slightly more powerful (+20 hp, +34 lb-ft) than the base car, thanks to faster-spinning turbochargers and a refined ignition system, the engineers spent the majority of their time making a more agile Z. The manual transmission offered on the regular Z was voted out from the start; it simply didn't shift fast enough. With that decision made, Nismo focused on stiffening the Z's chassis, developing grippier tires with Dunlop, and refining the car's aerodynamic kit. They even bolted in Z Nismo-specific Recaro seats so you and your passenger don't get too jostled.

To understand the subtle but significant changes to this Nismo Z, we pored over the car with performance development manager Christian Spencer, who has spent time behind the wheel of this car during its extensive testing at Buttonwillow Raceway in California.

Nissan hints at offering reproduction parts for all vintage Nissans

Twenty years ago, Nissan experimented with offering its vintage cars restored and on the showroom floor. Now it appears the company wants to take another stab at catering to the old-Nissan collector with a reproduction parts program.

Revealed earlier this week as part of a press conference announcing the NISMO Roadcar division, the Heritage Parts Program, which NISMO will oversee, will initially provide restoration parts for the R32 Skyline GT-R. However, according to NISMO's Takao Katagiri, the company intends to offer reproduction and restoration parts for other vintage Nissan (and presumably Datsun, Infiniti, and Prince) models should the R32 program prove successful.

Exactly which models, Katagiri didn't say. However, Nissan would presumably have a head start should it decide to offer restoration parts for 240Zs, given its 1996-1997 campaign to buy back, restore, and resell 1972-spec 240Zs.

While Nissan didn't restore those cars itself - instead, the company farmed out the task to Pierre'Z Service Center in Hawthorne, California - according to Japanese Nostalgic Car, the company did raid its new -old-stock inventory for carpets, seats, dashes, and upholstery and, when it couldn't find NOS parts, it commissioned new runs of reproduction parts. Rather than hoard them, Nissan apparently made those reproduction parts available over the counter as well and even went so far as to back the parts with the same 12-month/12,000-mile warranty the restored cars came with.

Only 37 cars came about from that experiment - a result of initial poor quality reports and steep asking prices - but it did generate plenty of publicity for Nissan and possibly foretold to what extent the company will support the Heritage Parts Program.

Nissan's Heritage Parts Program is scheduled to kick off this fall. The company did not specify whether the parts would be available just in Japan or in the United States as well.


Whether you were a car enthusiast or just looking for a great time, the event was one not to be missed with food trucks, raffle prizes and fun for everyone.


